If your workplace has 20 or more employees, under Ontario law you are required to have a joint health and safety committee with at least two members (one worker and one management representative) specially trained and certified in health and safety.

Certification training is a two-part process

Part One – participants learn about health and safety basics and their duties under the *Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA)*

Part Two – participants learn how to recognize, assess and control hazards specific to their workplace
